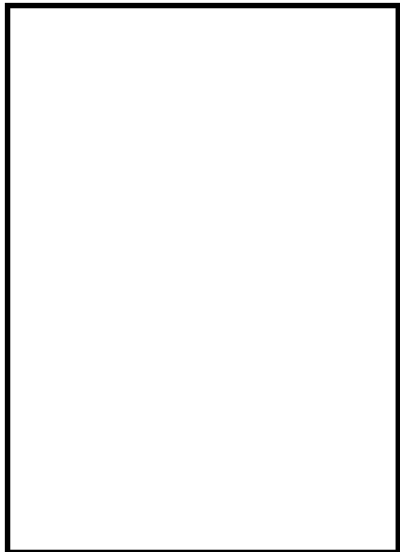

## Rigorous Assessments Some Days, Thought Provoking Ways

Examples:

Examining student work.  
Summative as formative  
(item analysis)  
Grades and grading  
practices.

Definition:

Philosophical Shift—  
Formative rather than  
summative.

## Routine Assessments Everyday, All day

Definition:

Maximizing, optimizing  
feedback from students.

Problem for asking Q's:  
Only a small amount of stu-  
dents respond. We make big  
decisions from a small  
amount of data.

Examples:

Tell & Retell (cognitive re-  
hearsal).

Signaling/Responding..  
Agree/Disagree,  
Yes/No, Etc.

“Tell me more....”  
+ wait time

## Reflective Assessments Many Days, Deliberate Ways

Definition:

Metacognitive and  
Reflective.

Examples:

One minute challenge (self  
assessment)  
Goal setting  
Metacognitive questions
